1. General Rules and Regulations as published in this catalogue govern this department.
2. Entry fee is 15 percent of the first premium, with a minimum fee of \$3.00.
3. Cattle to be brought on grounds between 10:00 AM to 6:00 P.M on Tuesday.
4. All pure bred cattle must be properly registered with certificates of registration accompanying.
5. All cows, three years or over, must have raised a calf this year.
6. Bull shown with herd may also compete in a single entry.
7. Ear tags or permanent tattoo markings required on all animals for identification.
8. Animals exhibited may not be removed until after 7:00 P.M., Monday.
9. **Proof of immunization for rabies for sheep, goats, cattle and swine is required and will be check by the Department Superintendent.**
10. Animal entered in Market Steer Section cannot be entered or shown in any other section.
11. Any animal with an inadequate body condition score will be rejected at the discretion of the superintendent.
12. Any exhibitors that do not follow the herdsmanship guidelines will be removed for the fairgrounds.
13. Beef cattle will be open to out of county residents – Out of county animals will be accepted on a space available basis with preference given to Montgomery & Fulton county residents first.

ALL CATTLE ENTRIES SHOULD BE MADE ON THIS FORM

TO: ALL DAIRY EXHIBITORS FROM: FONDA FAIR BOARD

Due to the severe penalties imposed by the State of New York Agricultural Department from the contamination of milk by antibiotics, we are forced to enact the following rules and regulations:

1. If antibiotics are detected in the milk, all users of the parlor facilities will have to supply a milk sample for each milking animal.
2. Individuals or parties found having antibiotics in milk, which was processed through parlor, will be liable for all financial loss created by contamination.
3. Individuals or parties responsible will be banned from livestock exhibition for a period of three (3) years.
4. Any tank of milk that gets rejected for any reason such as penicillin, etc., then **NO ONE** gets paid for that tank.

We regret having to take such severe measures, but find it necessary to protect all those individuals using the milking facilities.
