- ⇒ **No double entry allowed. One Entry in each class.**
- ⇒ Entries to be in place Tuesday 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM.
- ⇒ No article shall be permitted to be exhibited if it has been previously exhibited and no premium will be awarded.
- ⇒ When there is but one exhibit in any class its merits shall be considered with the same thoroughness as if it were in close competition. No premium shall be awarded if an exhibit is of inferior quality and will be noted in the judges' book as "Not Worthy".
- ⇒ All exhibits must be old and considered antique in the opinion of the judges. Judges will, whenever possible, publicly explain their reasons for the placing of premiums in order that the exhibitors may gain more knowledge in the requirements of this particular exhibit.
- ⇒ Any Item(s) of unusual size or shape shall be described at the Secretary's Office at least five (5) days in advance and will be accepted or not depending on space requirements.
- ⇒ Please extend every effort to properly place your exhibit in its category. If an item is entered but not brought in for exhibit, return your entry tag to the department head.
- ⇒ An award of \$10.00 and a Ribbon will be awarded to the exhibit which in the considered opinion of the judges and the department heads, to be the most unique and best of the display.
